Y8/9 Residential Visit to Le Quiou, Brittany France

We are organising a study visit to Le Quiou in Brittany, France for the pupils studying French in Y8 and Y9. The trip will leave King Edward VII School on **Sunday 23 June and will be returning on Friday 28 June 2019.**

We will be travelling to France by coach and ferry and will be staying in an activity centre. Each day during our stay we will participate in a full programme of activities and visit the local sights and attractions as well as completing language tasks to improve linguistic skills.

The cost of the visit will be approximately **£475** per child. This includes the cost of the coach, the ferry, full board accommodation, travel insurance and all the activities in France. However, your child will need some spending money.

If you would like your child to participate in this exciting educational visit please **fill in the reply slip** overleaf and return it **by Friday, 9th November 2018** at the latest, in a sealed envelope marked **"Y8/Y9 Brittany Visit"**. The envelopes should be handed in at the Lower School Office – not to a teacher.

Please pay the non-returnable deposit of **£100**, this will be used to secure the accommodation and travel arrangements. The deposit and further instalments for the visit should be made by **Parent Pay**. Those parents without online access will need to request a bar code to pay via a Pay Point. In this case, please can you contact the Lower School Office and the school will **provide you** with one. Those parents having difficulty setting up Parent Pay, should contact the Upper School Office.

Please also note students must have their own passport and EHI card (formerly E111). Passport applications are available from the post office; EHICs can be obtained via the internet at www.ehicard.org.uk
