Y7/8 Residential Study Visit to Spain

We would like to invite your child to join King Edward VII School's Y7 and Y8 Residential Study Visit to Spain. The visit will provide students with the opportunity to use some Spanish in an authentic context and broaden their knowledge of Spanish culture and society. The visit will take place on from **10th - 14th June 2019**

In Spain, we will be staying at an all-inclusive specialist centre on the Mediterranean Coast in Sotogrande in the province of Cadiz. Many of the activities will take place at the Centre itself when our students will work together with Spanish school students, there will also be an opportunity to visit a local Spanish secondary school. In addition, KES students will spend some time visiting places of cultural or historical interest such as the city of Malaga.

The cost of the trip will be approximately £615 to include travel to and from Spain, full board accommodation, insurance and all the activities/excursions in Spain. If you would like your child to participate in this exciting visit **please fill in the reply slip** overleaf and return it to the **Lower School Office by Friday 9th November**. It is school policy that no child should miss out on this kind of opportunity due to financial hardship; please indicate on the slip if you would like us to contact you to discuss how we can support your child to take part in this visit.

Please pay the non-returnable deposit of **£100 by Friday 9th November**. This will be used to secure the flights and accommodation. The deposit and further instalments for the visit should be made by **Parent Pay**. Those parents without online access will need to request a bar code to pay via a Pay Point. In this case, please can you contact the Languages Office at Upper School and the school will provide you with one. Those parents having difficulty setting up Parent Pay, should contact the Lower School Office.

Please note students **must have their own passport and EHI Card** (formerly E111). Passport applications are available from the post office, EHICs can be obtained via the internet at www.ehic.org.uk.
