The School will:

- aim to maintain a safe learning environment for students
- provide a broad, balanced curriculum that prepares students for their future lives and provide support in making choices
- strive to cater for the additional needs of all students
- regularly monitor students' achievement, progress, attendance and punctuality and provide feedback to parents/carers
- set and monitor homework through "Show My Homework" and provide facilities for students to do homework in School
- manage behaviour according to the School's Consistent Conduct Policy and apply rewards and sanctions using our best professional judgement
- encourage parents/carers to have a positive input into the School and keep them informed about School activities through letters, newsletters and academic reviews; all communicated via email and/or the School's website, or by post where specifically requested
- encourage parents/carers to contact School about any concerns they may have

Parents/Carers will:

- ensure that their child has excellent attendance and punctuality
- advise School about concerns or problems that might affect the child's work or behaviour
- support the School's policies and guidelines for behaviour
- encourage completion of homework, on time and in full
- ensure that their child comes to School appropriately dressed
- attend Parents' Evenings regularly
- attend other appointments arranged by School staff
- inform School promptly of reasons for absence from School
- only arrange holidays during published School holidays
- be courteous and considerate towards staff when communicating with School, modelling the behaviour we all expect from students
- make an appointment before coming to School to discuss issues with staff
- collect their child's mobile phone in person if it has been confiscated more than once during a half term

Students will:

- be ready for learning by eating sensibly, getting enough sleep and exercise and being properly equipped including having Consistent Conduct Book ready for inspection at all times
- complete all classwork, homework and coursework to the highest standard possible and hand it in on time
- join in learning positively, respecting the right of others to learn without disruption
- aim to achieve or exceed, attainment and progress targets
- aim for 100% attendance and punctuality to School and lessons
- be polite, respectful and co-operative to everyone in School and when travelling to and from School
- follow all rules and expectations and do as asked by staff straight away
- not use any language or engage in behaviour that could be interpreted as bullying, racist or homophobic
- respect and care for the School environment, the surrounding neighbourhood and for fellow students
- not bring into School anything to be sold to others or that could threaten the safety and well-being of others in the School community
- Ensure mobile phones and other electronic equipment are always switched off and out of sight inside School
