KING EDWARD VII SCHOOL A LEVEL RESULTS 2018

Students at King Edward VII School are celebrating in light of achieving excellent A Level examination results this summer. The results will enable students to pursue their chosen courses at many of the top universities in the country, including Oxford and Cambridge.

Additionally, from 594 examination entries:

- 60.3% of all entries were A* B (increase of 3.4% on the 2017 results)
- 31.0% of all entries were A* A (increase of almost 3% on the 2017 results)
- 10.6% of all entries were A* (increase of 4% on the 2017 results)
- 3 students achieved 4 A* grades
- 5 students achieved 3 A* grades
- 37 students achieved one A* or more
- The average grade for the best 3 A Levels is B -
- The pass rate was 97.5%
- Four students will be heading off to Oxford and Cambridge
- Five students will be studying Medicine at top universities
- Two students will be studying Dentistry at top universities

Linda Gooden, Headteacher, stated that, 'Our wonderful Year 13 students have continued the tradition of performing exceptionally well at A Level and they should be delighted with their results. They have demonstrated commitment, hard work and a genuine passion for learning to secure another strong set of results for the School.
